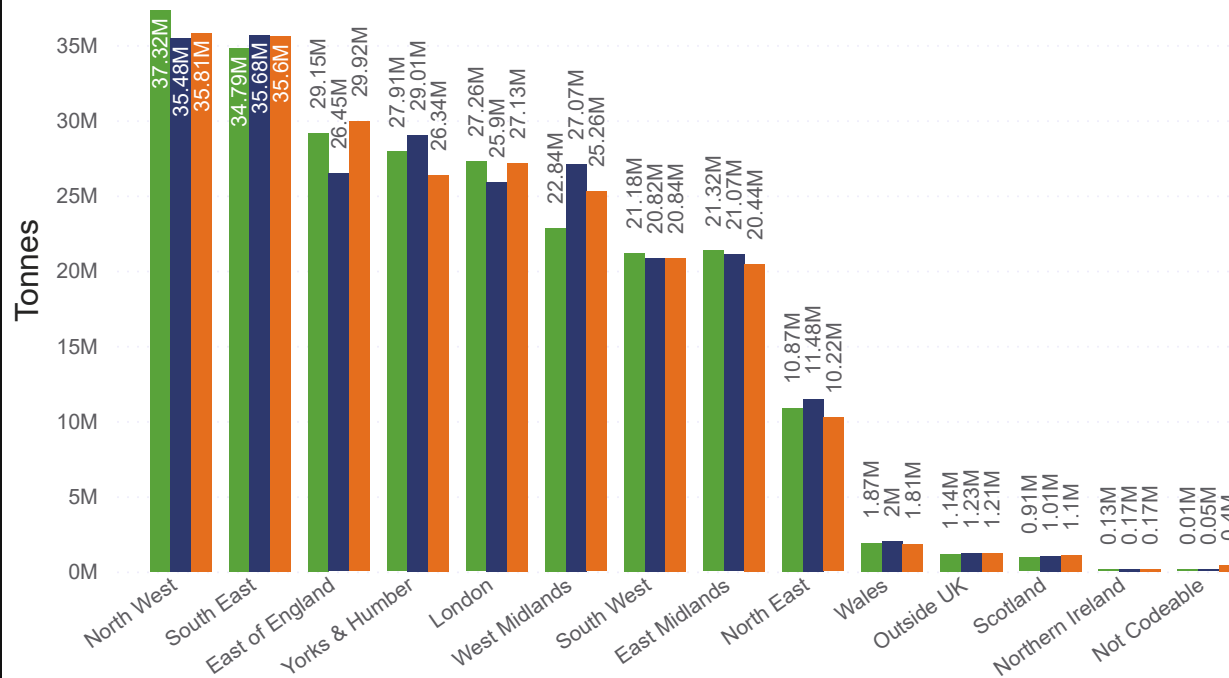

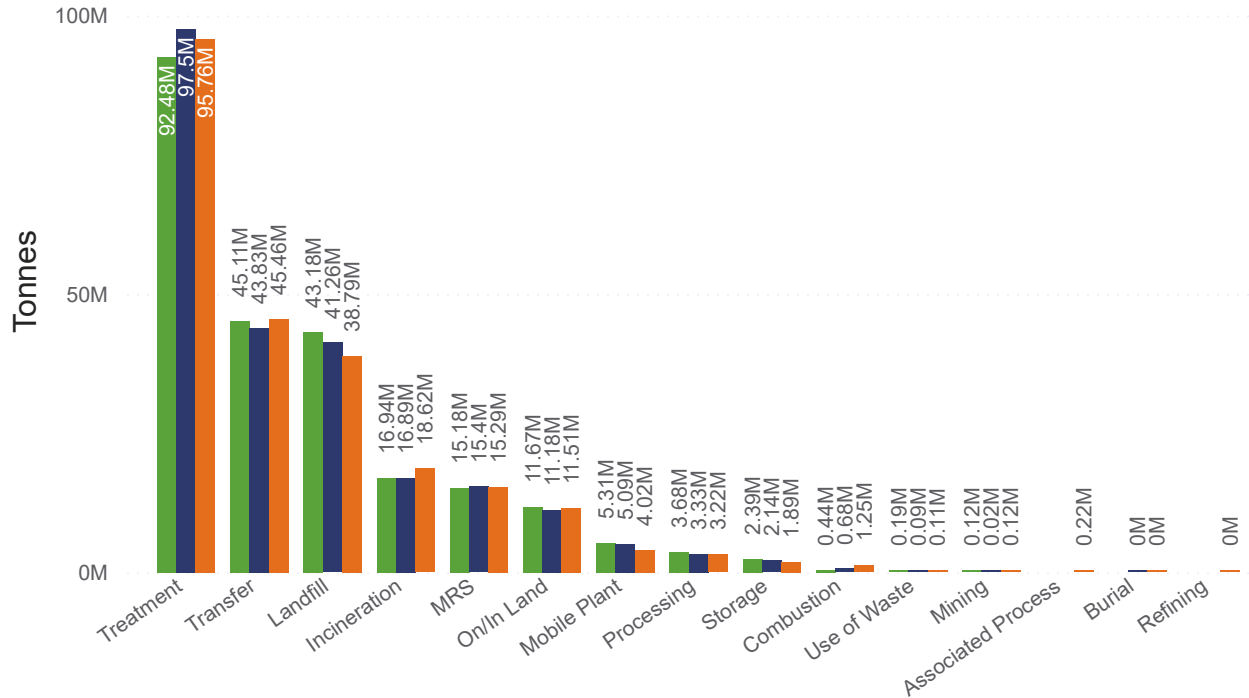

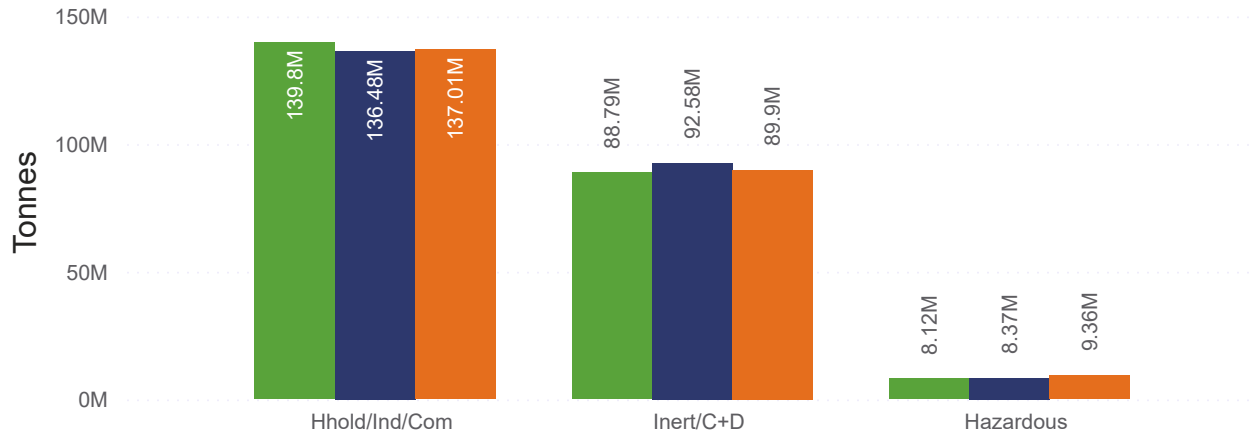
Tonnes by Site Type

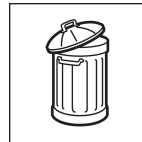

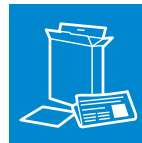

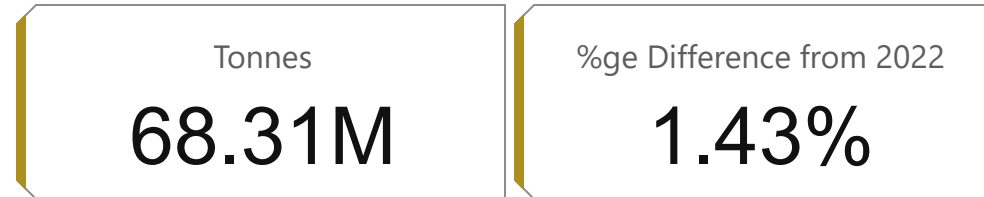

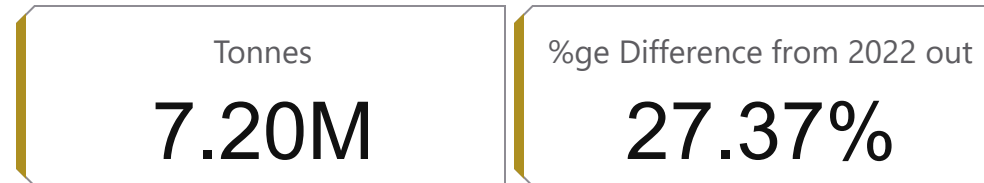

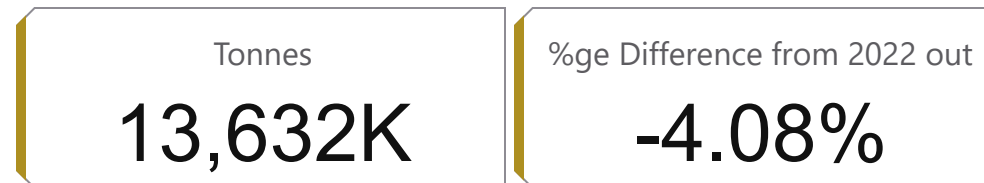
Combustible Waste Arriving into Sites (19 12 10)

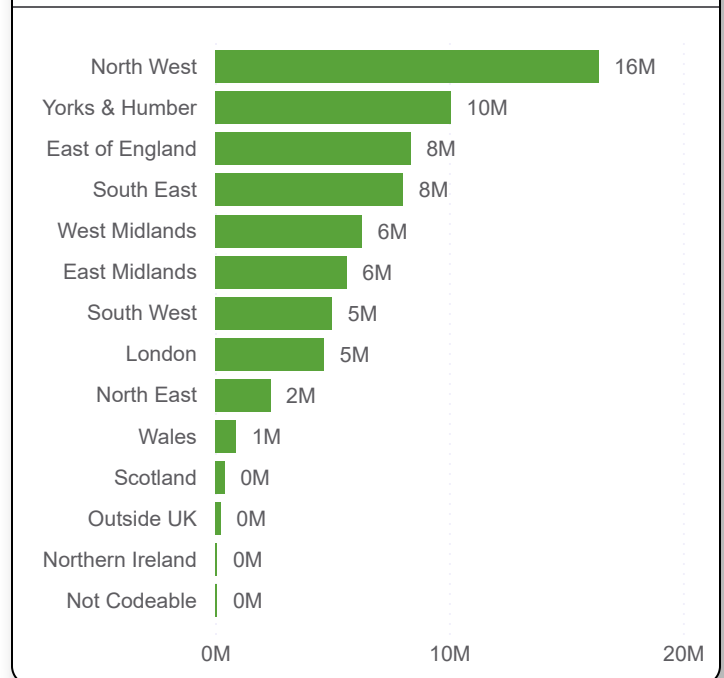

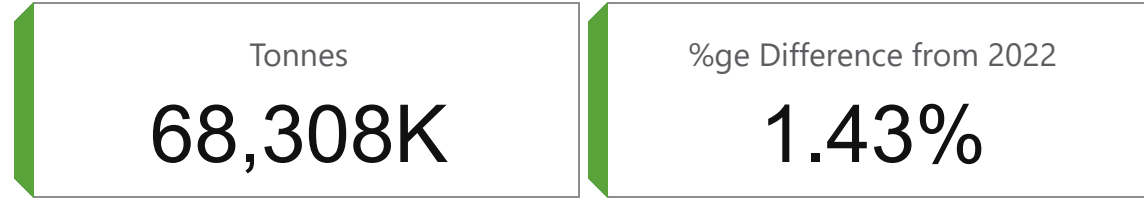

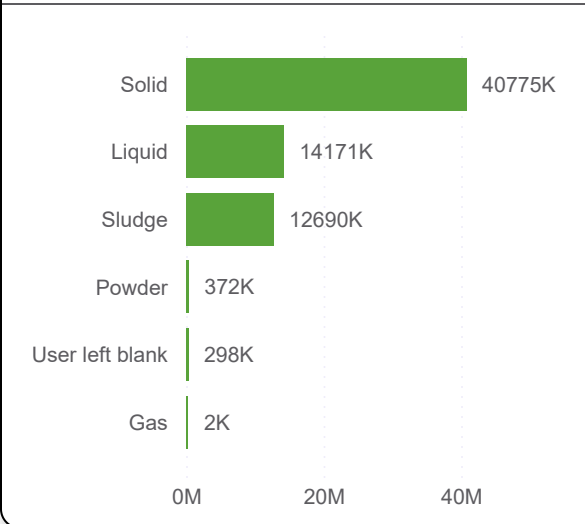


Combustible Waste (19 12 10)

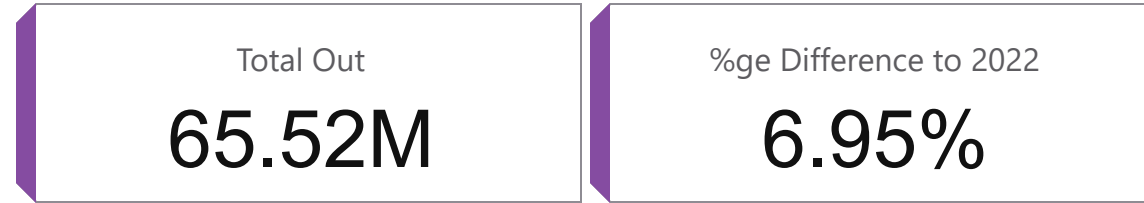

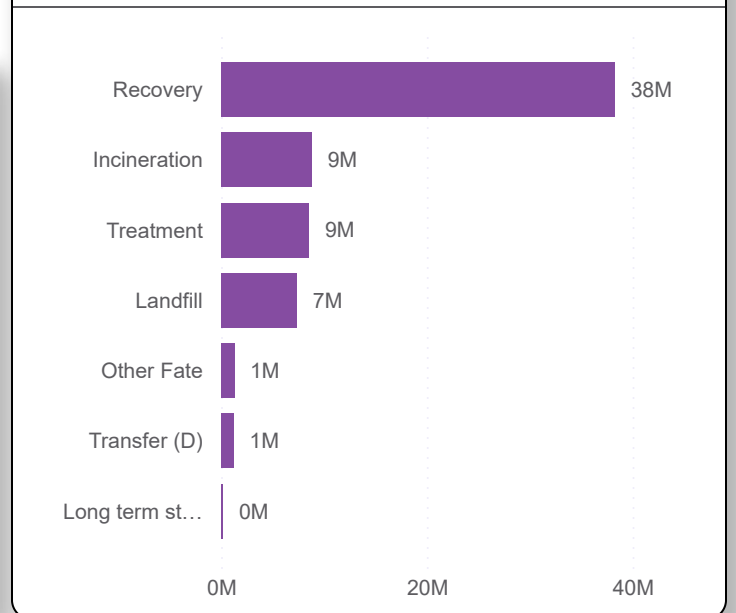
